Young Player (U8's - U16's) Code of Conduct

We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behavior in the game. As a player you have a big part to play. That's why The FA is asking every player to follow a Respect Code of Conduct.

When playing or training with London Football School (LFS), I will:

- Always play to the best of my ability.
- Play fairly - I won't cheat, complain or waste time
- Respect my team-mates, the other team, the referee and my coach/manager(s).
- Play by the rules as directed by the referee.
- Shake hands with the other team and the referee at the end of the game.
- Listen and respond to what my coach/manager(s) tell me.
- Talk to someone I trust or the club welfare officer if I'm unhappy about anything at LFS.

I understand that if I do not follow the code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by LFS, London FA or the FA:

I may:

- Be required to apologise to my team-mates, the other team, referee or my coach/manager(s).
- Receive a formal warning from the coach/manager(s) or the club committee.
- Be dropped or substituted.
- Be suspended from training.
- Be required to leave the club.

In addition:

LFS, London FA or The FA may make my parent or carer aware of any infringements of the Code of Conduct. The FA/London FA could impose a fine and suspension against LFS.
